

HOMESPUN'S STITCH-A-LONG

Give Thanks – Stitchery 5 (Angel)



Embroidery

1. Print these instructions for Stitchery 5 – Angel design. Before printing, check the Print dialog box – it is important that in the field next to the words “Page Scaling” you have selected “None”. This will ensure that the stitchery design that appears at the end of the instructions is exactly the right size.
2. From the cream quilter’s muslin or another background fabric of your choice, cut:
 - One square, 7½in.
3. From the lightweight fusible interfacing, cut:
 - One square, 7½in.
4. Centre the fabric over the design and trace it neatly with the fine Pigma pen or pencil. A light source such as a window, light box or glass-topped table with a desk lamp placed underneath will help to make the design more visible through the fabric.
5. Fuse the interfacing to the wrong side of the fabric. Place the fabric in an embroidery hoop, if desired.
6. Work the stitchery design, referring to the stitchery guide below.

Stitchery guide

Design area	DMC Stranded Embroidery Cotton	Stitch
Wording	Ultra Dark Coffee Brown (938) – one strand	Back stitch
Angel's dress	Medium Light Shell Pink (152)	Back stitch
Scallop trim on dress, collar and shoes	Medium Shell Pink (3722)	Back stitch
Scallop trim detail	Medium Shell Pink (3722) – one strand	French knots
Hair	Desert Sand (3064)	Back stitch
Face and hands	Light Tan (437)	Back stitch
Eyes	Ultra Dark Coffee Brown (938) – one strand	French knots
Mouth	Medium Shell Pink (3722) – one strand	Back stitch
Wings	Ultra Very Light Mahogany (3856)	Back stitch
Wing detail	Very Light Shell Pink (224) – one strand	French knots
Heart	Medium Shell Pink (3722)	Satin stitch
Heart trail	Medium Shell Pink (3722)	Running stitch
