Give Thanks – Stitchery 1 (Butterfly)



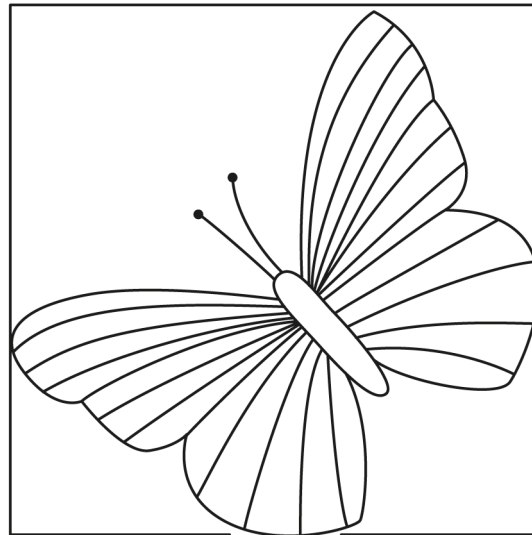
Embroidery

1. Print these instructions for Stitchery 1 – Butterfly design. Before printing, check the Print dialog box – it is important that in the field next to the words “Page Scaling” you have selected “None”. This will ensure that the stitchery design that appears at the end of the instructions is exactly the right size.
2. From the cream quilter’s muslin or another background fabric of your choice, cut:
 - One square, 7½in.
3. From the lightweight fusible interfacing, cut:
 - One square, 7½in.
4. Centre the fabric over the design and trace it neatly with a fine Pigma pen or pencil. A light source such as a window, light box or glass-topped table with a desk lamp placed underneath will help to make the design more visible through the fabric.
5. Fuse the interfacing to the wrong side of the fabric. Place the fabric in an embroidery hoop, if desired.
6. Work the stitchery design, referring to the stitchery guide on the following page.

Stitchery guide

Design area	DMC Stranded Embroidery Cotton	Stitch
Wings outline	Light Cornflower Blue (794)	Back stitch
Wing detail	Light Cornflower Blue (794) – one strand	Back stitch
Body and antennae	Ultra Dark Coffee Brown (938)	Back stitch and French knots
Border	Medium Lavender (210)	Back stitch
